The Division of Environmental Quality Office of Land Resources (DEQ) has determined the Pre-Application (Document ID 81514) for a proposed expansion of the Central Arkansas Recycling & Disposal Services (CARDS) Class 4 Landfill is administratively complete. In accordance with the requirements of APC&EC Regulation 22, the enclosed Public Meeting Notice must be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the county in which the proposed landfill expansion is located. Selection of the newspaper is subject to DEQ approval.

1. The enclosed Public Meeting Notice must be published at least twenty (20) calendar days prior to the date of the scheduled Public Meeting. The Public Meeting will be held in Little Rock, Arkansas, on Tuesday, February 7, 2023, at 6:00 p.m. at the Southwest Community Center, 6401 Baseline Road, Little Rock, Arkansas 72209.
2. Insert the date of the publication at the bottom of the public notice above the Chief Administrator's name.
3. Following publication, please forward the proof of publication of the Public Meeting Notice and a copy of the paid receipt to the Office of Land Resources to be included in the DEQ's permit modification document records for the CARDS Class 4 Landfill expansion. Please be

advised, if the applicant fails to publish the enclosed Public Meeting Notice, within the required timeframe, the project will be delayed and the meeting will have to be rescheduled.

On Wednesday, February 8, 2023, Office of Land Resources staff will meet at the proposed Class 4 Landfill site to conduct a preliminary site investigation of the proposed landfill areas per APC&EC Regulation 22.302(e)(1). The Office of Land Resources requests access to the site, a trackhoe and operator for digging test pits to depths of 15 to 20 feet below ground surface at the proposed landfill site, and any site utility clearances needed. Members of other regulatory agencies who may have an interest in the landfill may accompany the Office of Land Resources staff during the preliminary site investigation.

NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

Central Arkansas Recycling & Disposal Services, LLC Class 4 Landfill Existing Permit Number: 0314-S4-R1 AFIN: 60-04211

The Division of Environmental Quality (DEQ), under provisions of Rule No. 22 of the Arkansas Pollution Control and Ecology Commission, has scheduled a Public Meeting in Little Rock, Arkansas on February 7th, 2023, to discuss the proposed lateral expansion of the Central Arkansas Recycling & Disposal Services, LLC (CARDS) Class 4 Landfill located in Little Rock, Arkansas. The scheduled Public Meeting will be held in the Southwest Community Center located at 6401 Baseline Road, Little Rock, Arkansas. The Public Meeting is scheduled to begin at 6:00 p.m.

The DEQ Office of Land Resources (OLR) has determined CARDS has submitted an administratively complete Pre-Application requesting to construct a lateral expansion that includes an increase in both acreage and capacity at the CARDS Class 4 Landfill. The Class 4 Landfill would accept disposal of bulky, inert, non-putrescible wastes that do not degrade or degrade very slowly. The current Pre-Application contemplates an approximate increase of 83.4 acres and an increase in capacity. These increases are considered a major modification and a lateral expansion. The proposed expansion of the Class 4 Landfill is on property adjacent and to the east of the existing Class 4 Landfill and on property to the west and southwest of the existing Class 4 Landfill, across Ironton Road. The proposed CARDS Class 4 Landfill is located at 9611 Ironton Road, Little Rock, Arkansas. The proposed facility is on Ironton Road in Little Rock, Arkansas, just south of the West Dixon Road intersection. The proposed expansion is generally located in the central portion and southeast quarter of Section 2 and the southeast quarter of Section 3, Township 1 South, Range 12 West in Pulaski County, Arkansas.

The purpose of the Public Meeting is to provide interested persons with the opportunity to meet with DEQ OLR staff and informally discuss the agency's solid waste permitting process, as well as discuss the proposed CARDS Class 4 Landfill. Since the meeting is not a formal hearing, no prepared statements are necessary, and no record of the proceedings will be made.
